BUZZ Rules

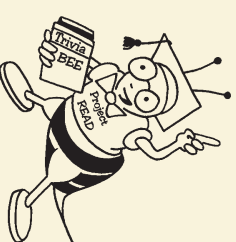
- Each team consists of three members with the Team Captain as the team spokesperson.
- There are Four Rounds: Qualifying, Semi-final, Final and, if necessary, Sudden Death.
- One point is given for each correct answer; there are no penalties for wrong answers. Each new round starts at zero.
- The Qualifying Round consists of 30 questions.
- The 15 teams with the highest score will compete in the Semi-final Round of 15 questions.
- The Final Round for the top 5 teams will have a total of 7 questions.
- The game moves toward the fourth round, a “Sudden Death” tie-breaker, only if there is a tie for 1st, 2nd or 3rd place.
